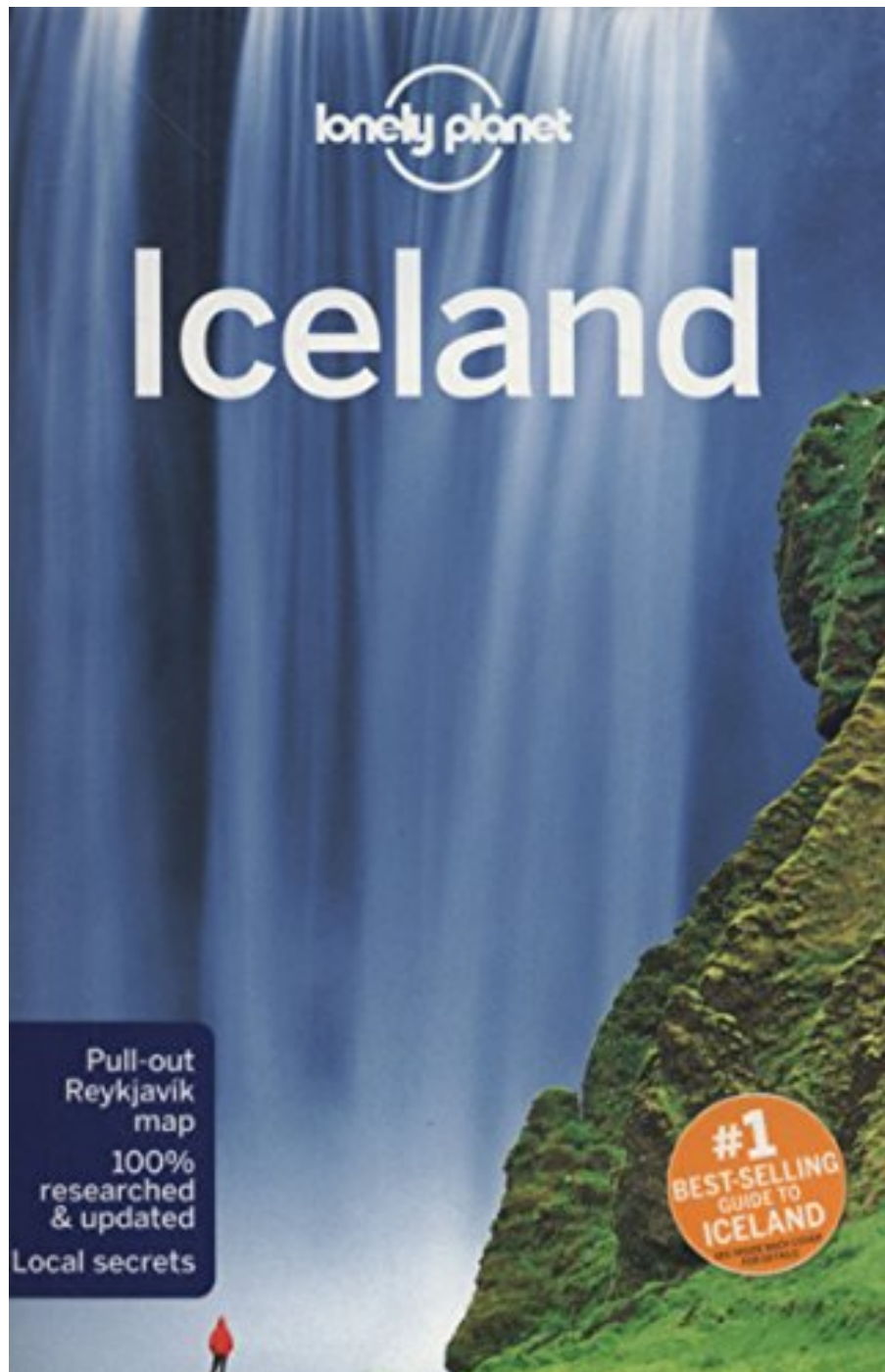

Detailed info about the different regions of Iceland, organized in a way that makes it easy to read aloud while you are driving through that area. Historical background plus current social and economic info about the cities (towns really) helped us understand the areas. We brought several guidebooks and quickly settled on this one as the best for info about both Reykjavik and other places in Iceland.
