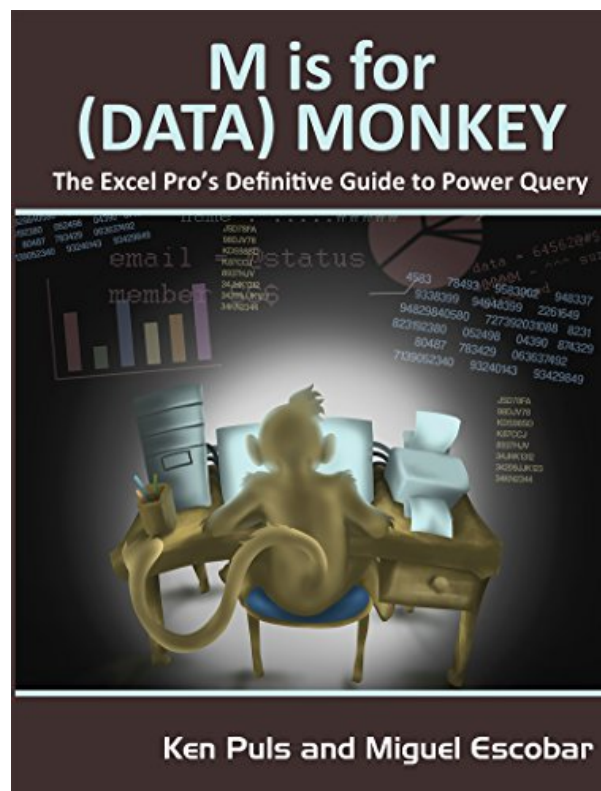

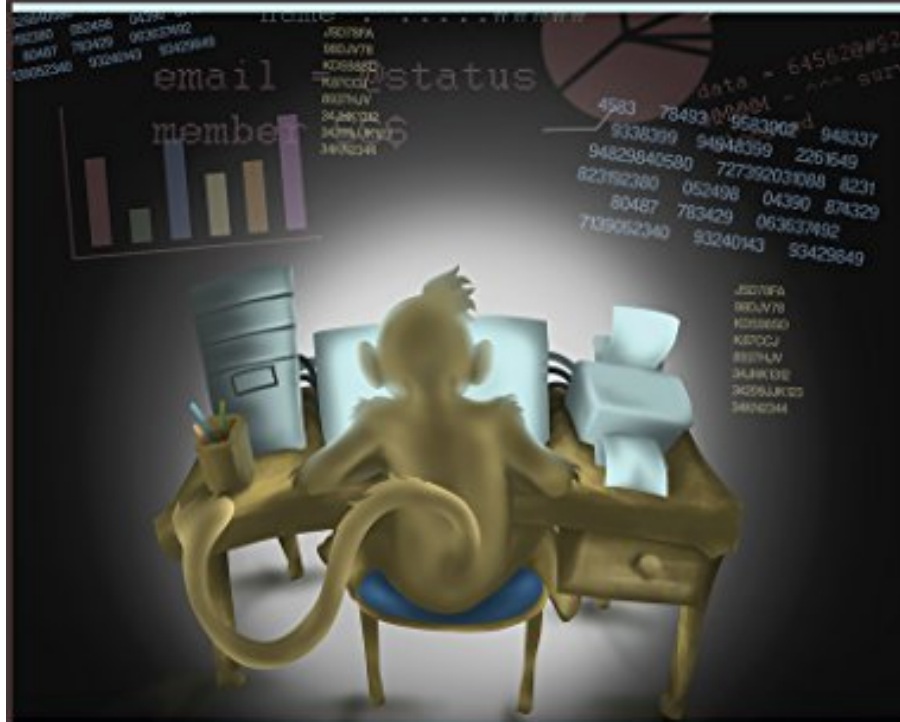

I was excited previously by Power Pivot and what was possible with it, but this book changed the way I looked at a
